How to get there:

From Turin:

by car, 60 minutes, route:

SR 29 as far as Borbore di Vezza d'Alba, then left onto SP 50

From Milan:

by car, 90 minutes, route:

A7 Motorway, then A21 and A33, exit Castagnito

By bus:

Sunday, from 10.30 am to 7 pm, every 30 minutes free outward and return transport is provided by Autobus Roero Docg, stopping at Montà (piazza San Michele), Canale (piazza San Bernardino), Guarene (Castello), Monteu Roero (piazza Roma).
